5 **POLICY REGARDING ATTIRE AND DECORUM IN THE COURTROOM**

7 The purpose of this administrative order is to address attire and
8 decorum when appearing in the Court.

9 The Court sees the need to show respect for the Court, and all persons
10 appearing before the Court have a responsibility to uphold the integrity of
11 the Court and conduct themselves in a professional and ethical manner.

12 **IT IS SO ORDERED** that all persons appearing before the Court shall adhere
13 to the following rules for attire and decorum.

- 14 1. Attire should at a minimum included full length pants or skirt, shirt
15 that covers upper body, and shoes. Over coats and jackets (not
16 including suit jackets) shall be removed upon entering the Courtroom.
17 2. Stand at the table when addressing the Court, unless instructed
18 otherwise by the Judge.
19 3. All sunglasses and hats (including stocking hats) shall be removed when
20 entering the Courtroom. This applies to all persons in the Courtroom
21 regardless of whether or not they address the Court.
22 4. Ask permission to approach the witness, bench or clerk's desk.
23 5. Do not address the opposing party unless granted permission by the
24 court and do not speak out of turn or interrupt others.


