	1c	People aged 65-74 years Persons aged 16-64 years with high-risk medical conditions Critical workers not recommended for vaccination in Phase 1b

Additional Vaccine Considerations:

- 2 doses 28 days apart
- 10 doses per vial; once vial is punctured, it's only viable for 6 hours
- It takes 2 hours for vaccine to thaw when moved from freezer to refrigerator
- Once vial is thawed (and un-punctured), it's viable for 30 days in refrigeration
- To ensure critical services remain operational, consideration is required for vaccinating entire departments vs. staggered vaccination to account for vaccinated people that experience side effects requiring time off
