WHAT IS FINANCIAL AID?

Financial aid consists of fund provided to students and families to *help* pay for postsecondary educational expenses.



TYPES OF AID

Gift Aid: Grants/Scholarships

- Pell Grant
- Oregon Promise Grant
- Oregon Opportunity Grant

Self-Help: Employment, Savings, Work-Study.

Loans: Federal/Private

ESSENTIAL GRANTS & SCHOLARSHIPS

FAFSA: Application for Federal Financial Aid. Opens October 1st Funding is first-come, first-serve

 OSAC: Scholarships for Oregon Students. With 1 application, apply for more than 500 scholarships.
Opens November 1st Closes March 1st

Oregon Promise Grant: Grant for Oregon students attending an Oregon Community College. Apply Today! Closes June 30th

 Oregon Opportunity Grant:
Grant for Oregon Students.
Automatically considered for the grant when you apply for the FAFSA.

Know Your Admission Deadlines: Use the College Booklets to help find your college deadlines.

FAFSA INFORMATION

- > Apply at: studentaid.gov
- Must file a FAFSA each year a student attends school to be eligible for funding.
- In most cases. parents will need to provide their tax information.

THE FAFSA IS FREE!

DOCUMENTS NEEDED

- Social Security Numbers
- > 2021 Federal Tax Returns
- 2021 Untaxed Income
- Checking/Savings Account Balances
- Investment Records as of filing date.
