CERTIFICATION OF RESULTS OF ELECTION

Under a Secretarial Election authorized by Kurt Fredenberg, Acting Northwest Regional Director, on September 13, 2022, the attached Amendment A to the Constitution of the the Confederated Tribes of the Grand Ronde Community of Oregon was submitted to the registered voters of the Grand Ronde Community on November 2, 2022. Amendment A was duly approved by a vote of 516 for and 163 against, and 0 cast ballots found to be spoiled in an election in which 2/3 of the voting membership must be in favor of the amendment per Article III, Section 1 of the Tribal Constitution and at least thirty percent (30%) of the 858 registered voters cast their ballots in accordance with 25 C.F.R. Part 81.



PROPOSED AMENDMENT  
CONSTITUTION OF THE  
CONFEDERATED TRIBE OF THE  
GRAND RONDE COMMUNITY OF OREGON

AMENDMENT NO. A

Proposed: ARTICLE V – MEMBERSHIP, Section 5, shall be amended to read as follows  
(changed text bold, underlined; removed text in strikeout):

ARTICLE V – MEMBERSHIP

Sec. 5. Loss of Membership. The Tribal Council shall by ordinance prescribe rules and regulations governing involuntary loss of membership. The reasons for such loss shall be limited exclusively to ~~failure to meet the requirements set forth for membership in this Constitution;~~

(a) **Fraud. Any person who was enrolled as a result of fraud.**

(b) **Dual Enrollment. Any member who is enrolled as a member in any other federally recognized Indian tribe.**

~~provided, that a~~ Nothing in this section shall prohibit a member from voluntarily relinquishing membership in the Confederated Tribes of the Grand Ronde Community of Oregon, with the consent of the Tribal Council.
