Learning Goals: Using the "Lifeways" educational video from the CTGR (youtube), students will practice informational note-taking to learn about the traditional lands, plants and uses from the Confederated Tribes of Grand Ronde archives.

Some of the Common Core Anchor Standards (grades 6-8) are as follows:

Reading/Key Ideas and Details

- *Read closely to determine what the text [video] says explicitly and to make logical inferences from it; cite specific textual evidence when writing or speaking to support conclusions drawn from the text.
- *Determine central ideas of themes of a text [video] and analyze their development; summarize the key supporting details and ideas.
- *Determine the meaning of words and phrases as they are used in a text [video], including figurative, connotative, and technical meanings; analyze the impact of a specific word choice on meaning and tone.

Writing/Research to Build and Present Knowledge

- *Conduct short, as well as more sustained, research projects based on focused questions, demonstrating understanding of the subject under investigation.
- *Draw evidence from literary or informational texts to support analysis, reflection, and research.
- *Write routinely over extended time frames and shorter time frames for a range of tasks, purposes, and audiences.

Speaking/Comprehension and Collaboration

- *Prepare for and participate effectively in a range of conversations and collaborations with diverse partners, building on others' ideas and expressing their own clearly and persuasively.
- *Adapt speech to a variety of contexts and communicative tasks, demonstrating command of formal English when indicated or appropriate.

Prior to sharing the CTGR video, "Lifeways", engage students in a "free-write/warm-up" activity using the CTGR Lifeways KWL - Re-group for whole classroom considerations of what is known SO far. Direct students to use their graphic organizers to take structured notes on the video. Following the activity, meet for a whole-class discussion/review notes and complete the KWL.
