Subject: The Committee recommends the Tribal Council adopt a resolution to approve the Oregon Statewide Transportation Improvement Fund Transit Plan application for fiscal years 2025 to 2027, and authorize the Tribe's Public Works Coordinator to submit and electronically sign the plan application.					
EXECUTIVE SUMMARY (Brief summary of reason / need for action)					
The State of Oregon through its transportation division, the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) created the Statewide Transportation Improvement Fund (STIF) for improved public transit that includes fund allocations to the Grand Ronde Tribe. The STIF Plan requires new applications to be sent to ODOT every two years that aligns with the State of Oregon's fiscal year biennium, with the next biennium beginning July 1, 2025 and ends on June 30, 2027. The STIF Plan intends to fund operating assistance for existing transit routes the serve the Grand Ronde community providing access to neighboring communities.

Resolution No. 001-25

WHEREAS, the Grand Ronde Tribal Council, pursuant to Article III, Section I of the Tribal Constitution approved November 30, 1984, by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary of the Interior, Indian Affairs, is empowered to exercise all legislative and executive authority not specifically vested in the General Council of the Confederated Tribes of the Grand Ronde Community of Oregon; and

WHEREAS, in 2006 the Grand Ronde community area lacked adequate public transportation services and elders, the disabled, and lower income people are strongly impacted by the lack of transportation options; and

WHEREAS, in 2007 the Grand Ronde Tribe prepared a Coordinated Public Transit - Human Services Transportation Plan to bring services to Grand Ronde; and

WHEREAS, in 2019 the Tribe prepared and adopted a new Transit Development Plan and Coordinated Transportation Plan for the Grand Ronde community area; and

WHEREAS, the State of Oregon through its transportation division, the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) created the Statewide Transportation Improvement Fund (STIF) for improved public transit for 2022-23, and 2024-25 including allocation to the Grand Ronde Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe solicited for comments and suggestions, through surveys and public input meetings to prepare a new Transit Plan and from that resulted in the Tribe preparing a fiscal year FY 2021 to 2023 STIF plan to use the funds to provide new public transportation services benefitting Tribal members and other residents of the Grand Ronde community area; and

WHEREAS, the Grand Ronde Tribe's Transportation Advisory Committee reviewed and recommended approval of the FY 2021 to 2023 STIF plan to help meet the needs of this rural community; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council approved the FY 2021 to 2023 by Resolution Number 027-21 on January 27, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe followed the same process as described in the approval of the FY 2021 to 2023 to approve the FY 2023 to 2025 by Resolution Number 42-23 on March 8, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the process is underway for the Tribe to apply for STIF plan funding for State of Oregon FY 2025 to 2027; and

WHEREAS, the Grand Ronde Tribe's Public Works Department completed a FY 2025 to FY 2027. STIF Application for presenting to the Transportation Advisory Committee, a Subcommittee of the Elders Committee for committee review on December 18, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe's Public Works Coordinator recommends that Tribal Council approve the FY 2025 to 2027 STIF Application so that the complete application can to be sent to ODOT by the due date on January 16, 2025.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Council hereby approves the Oregon Statewide Transportation Improvement Fund Transit Plan application for FY 2025 to 2027, and authorize the Tribe's Public Works and Tribal Transportation Program Manager to submit and electronically sign the plan application.

CERTIFICATION: the Tribal Council of the Confederated Tribes of the Grand Ronde Community of Oregon adopted this resolution at a regularly scheduled meeting, with a quorum present as required by the Grand Ronde Constitution, held on January 01, 2025 by a vote of 8 yes, 0 no and 0 abstentions.
