ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 24-003

POLICY REGARDING COURT DOCKET DAYS

The purpose of this administrative order is to address court docket days.

WHEREAS, Article IV of the Grand Ronde Constitution vests authority to the Chief Judge to exercise all judicial authority of the Tribe, to include the power to review and overturn tribal legislative and executive actions.

WHEREAS, Tribal Court Ordinance Chapter 302 provides for the administration of law and justice by the Confederated Tribes of Grand Ronde through the establishment of a Tribal Court system as required by Article IV of the Grand Ronde Constitution.

WHEREAS, Tribal Court Ordinance Chapter 302 empowers the court to exercise the judicial authority of the Tribe as delegated herein.

WHEREAS, the Court recognizes the need to have set docket days for the administration of the court.

THEREFORE, unless otherwise stated in an Ordinance, the following rules will apply.

1. Regular docket days for matters coming before the Court are the first and third Wednesday of every month, with a special set day on the third Thursday of every month, or as designated by the Chief Judge.

1 2. Hearings will commence at 8:30 a.m. with the last hearing of the day
2 commencing no later than 3:30 p.m.

3 3. Public Safety Court will be conducted on the third Wednesday of every
4 month from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m.

5 **THEREFORE**, Administrative Order 23-001 is hereby vacated.

6 This order shall remain in effect until further notice or until superseded
7 by future order.
