### What is Sovereignty?

#### CS

- Sovereignty- the act of having independent power, political, social and economic, or being free.
- All 9 federally recognized tribes in Oregon are sovereign nations.
- Tribal sovereignty is <u>not</u> a privilege, but a <u>right</u>.
- So, what does that mean???

## Tribal Sovereignty

- The United States government recognizes federally recognized tribes as self governing nations.
- There is a **government-to- government** relationship
  between federally recognized
  tribes and the US government.

- Rorm their own government
- Make and enforce laws
- □ Decide membership requirements

- And much more.
